The Ground Water Quality Bureau of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed the ARCADIS submittal titled, *Vegetation Monitoring Report for “Golf Course” Interim Remedial Action, Smelter\Tailing Soils Investigation Unit* (Report) received May 14, 2014. The Report was prepared by ARCADIS on behalf of Freeport McMoRan Copper & Gold, Chino Mines Company (Chino). Chino has sufficiently addressed the informal comments NMED submitted via email on April 25, 2014. NMED accepts this revised document as written, and Chino may cease vegetation monitoring for the Golf Course Interim Remedial Action based on re-establishment of the plant community and canopy coverage within the disturbed areas.
