The Ground Water Quality Bureau (GWQB) of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received the Annual Monitoring Report for the Groundhog Mine Site IRA, Hanover/Whitewater Creek Investigation Unit dated November 1, 2021 from Freeport-McMoRan Chino Mines Company (Chino). NMED has reviewed the Report and hereby approves the Annual Monitoring Report.

NMED continues to review the Draft Sitewide Abatement Stage 1 Final Investigation Report, including sections related to the Groundhog Mine Site and the concentration trends discussed in previous correspondence. In addition, NMED is currently reviewing the renewal application for DP-484, which will combine two other Discharge Permits into DP-484. This action would remove oversight of the Groundhog Lower Pond Collection System from the AOC and place that area under the jurisdiction of DP-484.
