

IMPACT OF FREEPORT-MCMORAN ON ECONOMY OF EL PASO COUNTY AND TEXAS FROM MINING-RELATED OPERATIONS – 2017



Freeport-McMoRan generated an estimated **\$133.2 million** in economic benefits for El Paso County and approximately **\$445.9 million** for New Mexico in 2017.

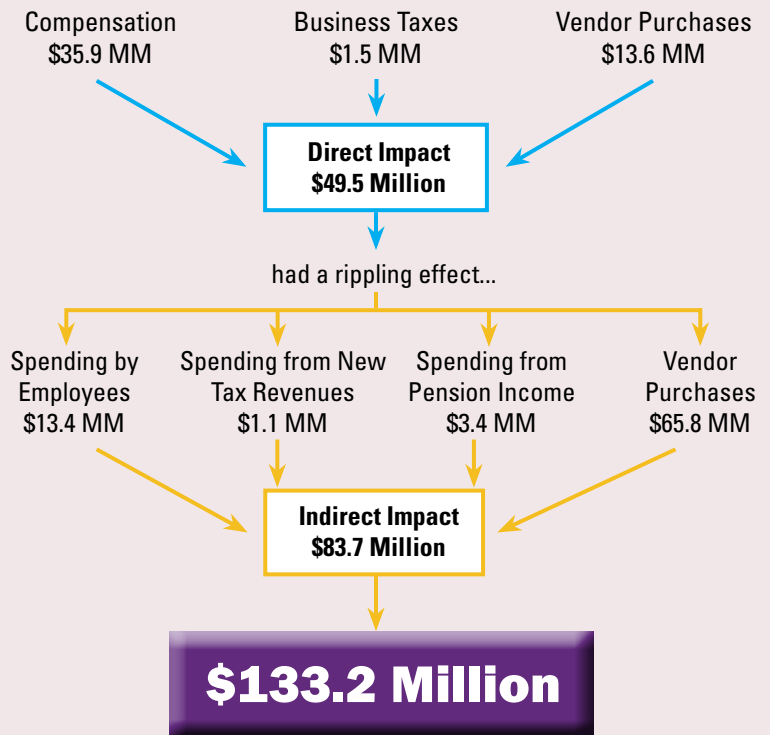

The charts to the right explain how Freeport-McMoRan provides such a boost to the county and state economies.

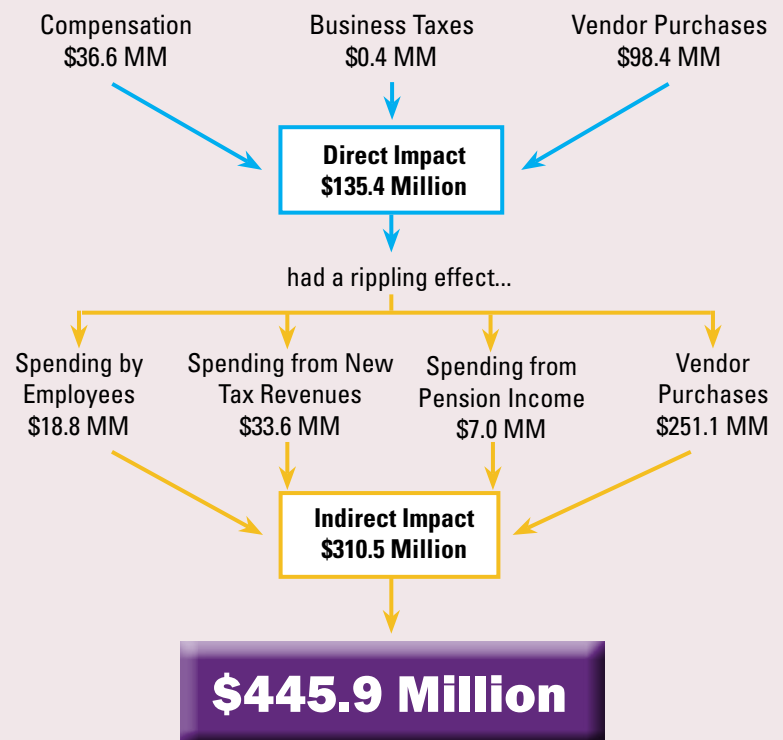
Freeport-McMoRan employed nearly 390 employees in Texas at the end of 2017 and had a total impact of more than 3,400 jobs on the state's economy.
