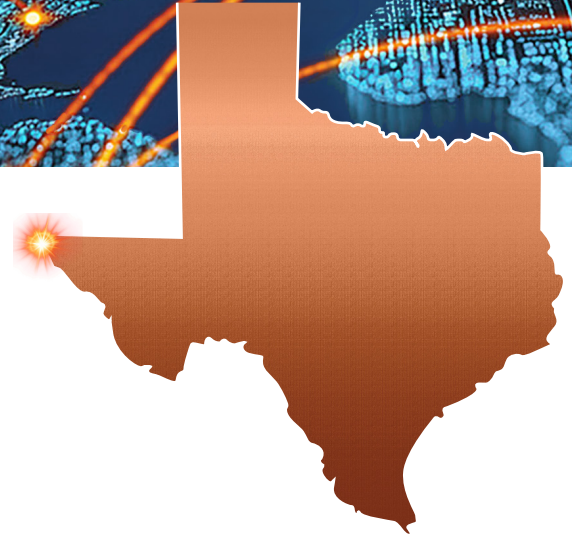


## TEXAS OPERATIONS 2024 ECONOMIC IMPACT

Freeport-McMoRan's Texas operations generated nearly **\$969 MILLION** in economic benefits for Texas in 2024, which includes over **\$248 MILLION** for El Paso County.

## ECONOMIC BENEFITS

The Texas operations **EMPLOYED 485** and the ripple effect of wages and taxes, plus services we purchased, created a total of **7,618 JOBS** in the state, generating additional economic benefits.
