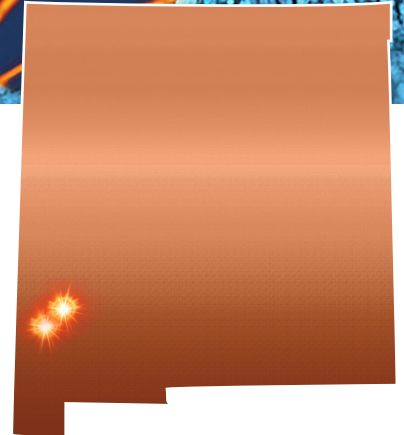


NEW MEXICO OPERATIONS 2024 ECONOMIC IMPACT

Freeport-McMoRan's New Mexico operations generated nearly **\$468 MILLION** in economic benefits for New Mexico in 2024, which includes over **\$196 MILLION** for Grant County.
